### Overview

The Vineyard Team is pleased to announce educational scholarships available to 2018 graduating high school seniors and currently enrolled college students. Students whose parent(s) or guardian(s) are vineyard workers employed or contracted by a member of the Vineyard Team are invited to apply. Scholarships will be awarded based on academic excellence and financial need. Awards will range from \$1,000 - \$5,000 per student. The number of scholarships awarded will be based on fund availability.

The Vineyard Team is a 501(c)3 non-profit grower-group dedicated to sustainable winegrowing since 1994. Over 20+ years, we have built a network of 300 local farmers, educating and guiding towards sustainable vineyard practices. We strive to protect both natural and human resources, and this scholarship represents our strong commitment to the social aspect of sustainability.
