



# HEAT ILLNESS PREVENTION

*Agricultural operations with outdoor workers are required to implement their high heat procedures and also take into consideration the company's COVID-19 preventative measures.*

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*Review your company's high heat procedures and emergency action plan with your supervisors and employees.*

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*Ensure regular communication with employees includes: Making sure a supervisor or designated person is supervising 20 or fewer employees and/or enact a mandatory buddy system. For lone workers, make sure you are regularly communicating via radio or cell phone.*

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*If employees are wearing facemasks make sure to check for symptoms of heat illness.*

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*Supply ample water and encourage employees to drink water throughout their shift.*

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*Ensure you have enough shade for employees to be at least six feet apart.*

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*Remind employees of their rights to take a cool-down break when necessary.*
